

## **SFI/TRI COURSE A320/A330**

This course is designed for pilots who would like to obtain the individual and practical qualification as a pilot instructor on the A320 & A330. It is conducted in accordance with Part – FCL.930 Regulations (EASA).

### **PREREQUISITES:**

- Professional license issued by an EASA member state, or a non EASA license acceptable to the authority
- Minimum 1500 hrs. on multi-pilot aeroplanes
- Successfully completed A320/A330 Type Rating course

### **FCL.915.SFI**

- Within the last 12 months preceding the application, candidate must have completed:
  - Proficiency check
  - 3 legs on applicable aircraft type (or 2 LOFT based simulator sessions)

### **FCL.915.TRI**

- At least 30 route sectors completed within the last 12 months preceding the application, to include take offs and landings as Pilot-in-Command or Co-Pilot on the applicable aircraft type s/he will instruct, of which not more than 15 sectors may be completed in a full flight simulator
